Studenterlauget's Buddy Programme is an initiative striving to create closer relations between local AU BSS students and new international degree students, and to introduce the international degree students to the true Aarhus experience.

By being a Buddy, you will:

- Develop yourself on a personal level and learn to take responsibility for others
- Expand your international network and your network at AU BSS
- Improve your second language through interaction with international students
- Get a fun job with a lot of interesting challenges
- Participate in different kinds of social events, team competitions and parties
- Receive a diploma for your time and dedication

Being a Buddy includes:

- Being in a Buddy Team (with approx. 5 other Buddies and their Newcomers)
- Being prepared to answer questions about SL, AU BSS and Denmark
- Giving advice on different practicalities the international students may have (e.g. shopping, transportation etc.)
- Picking up the degree students on the day of their arrival in Aarhus, if possible
- Arranging a minimum of 2 events during the fall semester with your Buddy Team
- Participating in different events with the Newcomers and other Buddies
- Being engaged for the whole Buddy Programme and participating in the events

As a Buddy you are hired for a period of six months (from June-November 2019).

If the position has caught your interest, please send us an application at buddy@studenterlauget.dk no later than **April 30th, 2019**. Interviews will be held continuously. In your application you should include your nationality, degree, student programme, semester and if you have been a Buddy or Newcomer before. It is possible to apply by yourself or as a group of 2-6 people. Furthermore, we would like to know why you would like to become a part of this programme.
