- Arranging a minimum of 1 event during the fall semester with your Buddy Team
- Participating in different events with the whole Buddy Programme and other SL members
- Being able to participate in our information meeting May 25th

As a Buddy you are hired from June and during the fall semester 2023. *Please note*: It is possible to be both a Buddy and an **Introduction Week Rusinstruktor** if you are interested in this.

In your application, you should include: your nationality, study line, semester and if you have been a Buddy or Newcomer before.

It is possible to apply by yourself or apply as a group of maximum 2 people.
